



## Scholarship to attend the Fifth International Conference LANGUAGE – PROFESSION – SCIENCE – 2.1

Last year, the IATEFL ESPSIG established a scholarship tradition aimed at encouraging the membership in striving for professional development, innovative and inspiring teaching in the field of English for Specific Purposes, as well as at providing a valuable opportunity for the exchange of good practices and enhanced awareness of experience, observations and ideas.

We started by offering one scholarship for the IATEFL conference in Liverpool 2019. For the IATEFL conference in Harrogate 2021, we offered two scholarships for participation in the conference and the ESPSIG's Pre-Conference Event.

Following the tradition, the ESPSIG committee has decided to extend the scholarship scheme and give ESP professionals the chance to take part in ESP events organised solely by ESPSIG, and jointly with other English teaching organisations.

The IATEFL ESPSIG will support the **Fifth International Conference LANGUAGE – PROFESSION – SCIENCE – 2.1** organised by the Foreign Language and Literature Association of Serbia, the Special Interest Group of Languages for Specific Purposes and the Teacher Education Faculty, University of Belgrade by offering one scholarship to a local expert in the teaching of English for Specific Purposes.

The ESPSIG scholarship of 93GBP will be offered to applicants interested in attending and presenting at the event. The award consists of:

- registration for the event
- a one-year IATEFL and ESPSIG membership

To qualify you must:

- be, or become, an IATEFL ESPSIG member
- agree to attend and present at the event
- write a report to be published in the IATEFL ESPSIG journal to be submitted by no later than **15 May 2021** (the focus of this article must be ESP) at **[espsigscholarships@gmail.com](mailto:espsigscholarships@gmail.com)**

To be considered you should submit:

- a speaker proposal in line with the event theme
- a summary of 400-500 words outlining your plans for facilitating ESP in your area and promoting the ESPSIG in your country

The winner will be informed by email by **19 February 2021**.
