- 14 Didactic methodological support to novice teachers of foreign languages for specific purposes;
- 15 Strengthening the professional identity of teachers of foreign languages for specific purposes;
- 16 Strengthening the role of languages for specific purposes in the academic and general public;
- 17 Other topics related to languages for specific purposes and languages for academic purposes.

Applications with abstracts should be sent as Word documents (named: Conference abstract) to the following email address: lspepsigbg2021@gmail.com no later than 5 February 2021.

Your application should contain the following:

- 1 Name and Surname of the author(s);
- 2 Affiliation of the author(s);
- 3 Email address of the author(s);
- 4 Title of the paper (up to 10 words);
- 5 Proof-read abstract of 150-200 words with a description of the objectives, methodology and (expected) research results;
- 6 Key words (5 key words);
- 7 The key conference stream that the talk belongs to (1 - 5).

Accepted abstracts will be published in the Book of abstracts. After the conference, selected papers will be published in the Conference Proceedings.

A maximum of two abstracts may be submitted per presenter (with only one as the first author).

All other speakers: **20 minutes** (additional 5 minutes for discussion)
